Uganda Education Project Update

When the 2019 Women's Team (5 women led by Ruth Stanley who took the name 'WonderWomen') from Apostles came back from their time of relationship-building and ministry in Uganda, they invited the congregation to support the education of girls by becoming sponsors of individual female students. **In the past year the funds sent to support these girls have made a significant difference in this time of the pandemic: teachers were paid, the schools were able to be Covid –ready, and a girl's dormitory was built. (see the picture)** The pandemic continues to be disruptive and some of the sponsored girls may not be returning to school this year. Ruth Stanley is contacting sponsors about the ongoing needs and how to respond. Thanks to all who give to make a difference for young girls in Uganda. We are grateful for our long term partnership with the Diocese of Bunyoro-Kitara.

Rental Assistance Ministry 2020



During the Fall of last year, a team of 8 from Apostles worked to help renters in financial distress find funding during the Covid crisis. The program was managed

by The Catholic Action Center in partnership with the Lexington Fair Housing Authority. Funding streams came from government Covid grants, churches and private sources. After orientation, the team began to make phone calls every week to help renters make application for available funds and making contacts with the landlords also. Over the 12 weeks the team made 250+ phone calls. From benevolent fund money and Vestry mission money Apostles donated \$8,250 to the work of rental assistance.
