Outside the Walls...

- The Vestry voted in August to send \$5,000 to Uganda to help the ministries of Bishop Sam Kahuma and Canon Eric Twine during this Covid time. These funds helped pay church staff salaries and fund ongoing radio ministries (their version of online services) during their lockdown. This past weekend they just began to hold in person services again at a reduced capacity.
- We have partnered with Catholic Action Center and the Lexington Fair Housing Authority to help renters make application for funds set aside for the ongoing rental crisis due to economic fallout from Covid shutdown. 7 members of Apostles are making phone calls during the week to help people in crisis fill out applications for funds. This ministry is helping people avoid homelessness and also helping get funds to landlords who are facing the financial stress of unemployed renters.
